

## **MASS AT MARYMOUNT HERMITAGE AND BLESSING OF MERCY HOUSE**



On April 11, 2018,  
Bishop Peter F. Christensen, Bishop of Boise,  
will offer Mass at 11 AM and then bless Mercy  
House and the icons and religious images there.

All are welcome to this public event.  
So that you can adequately plan your attendance,  
these details are offered as helpful guidelines.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION FOR GUESTS:**

1. Mass will begin at 11 AM. Please arrive early enough to park your car and walk to the chapel.
2. After Mass, we will all process over to Mercy House where the Bishop will bless the building and religious images there.
3. There will be no formal reception, only informal visiting in and around Mercy House after the blessing.
4. If you are interested in making a donation to Marymount Hermitage, your generosity would be appreciated since there are new and on-going expenses for Mercy House.
5. Available facilities for public use will be one bathroom in the chapel and two in Mercy House.

### **INFORMATION FOR PRIESTS:**

1. Visiting Catholic priests are welcome to concelebrate with Bishop Christensen.
2. Please bring an alb and white stole.
3. It would be helpful for planning sanctuary furniture, if priests would RSVP to Sister M. Beverly.

### **INFORMATION FOR OVERNIGHT GUESTS:**

Out-of-state guests have asked for lodging at Marymount Hermitage in order to attend Mass and the Blessing. Currently, there are no hermitages available. Please contact the Frontier Inn in Cambridge Idaho for reservations at the nearest motel.

## **DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO MARYMOUNT HERMITAGE:**

### **From the NORTH:**

1. Traveling south on State Highway 95, after you pass through Council, Idaho, find mile marker #129. This occurs just as you cross the bridge of the Middle Fork of the Weiser River.
2. Travel 1/2 mile south from the mile post to the top of Mesa hill.
3. Turn right onto Hermitage Lane which crosses a cattle guard and ascends a small hill. There is no sign at the highway and this is a blind turn. Be careful of traffic behind you!
4. A small sign to the left of the cattle guard indicates that this is Hermitage Lane.
5. Drive in about 1/2 mile and park in front of chapel.
6. Please park your own car.



### **From the SOUTH:**

1. Traveling north on State Highway 95, after you pass through Cambridge, Idaho, find mile marker #128. This occurs just after you see the Mesa highway sign. Do not turn yet!
2. Travel 1/2 mile north from the mile post to the top of Mesa hill.
3. Turn left onto Hermitage Lane which crosses a cattle guard and ascends a small hill. There is no sign at the highway and this is a blind turn. Be careful of traffic behind you!
4. A small sign to the left of the cattle guard indicates that this is Hermitage Lane.
5. Drive in about 1/2 mile and park in front of chapel.
6. Please park your own car.
