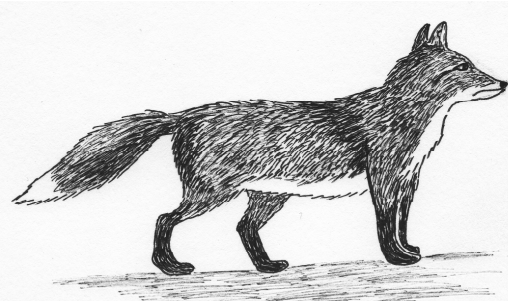


THE FIRE KING
